Modern foreign languages SEND intent

At Moss Valley, we believe in the importance of language for all our children. Learning languages gives pupils opportunities to develop their listening, speaking, reading and writing skills and to express themselves with increasing confidence. They explore the similarities and differences between other languages and English.

To make French lessons inclusive, teachers need to anticipate what barriers to taking part and learning particular activities, lessons or a series of lessons may pose for pupils with particular SEN and/or disabilities. In some activities, pupils with SEN and/or disabilities will be able to take part in the same way as their peers. In others, some modifications or adjustments will need to be made to include everyone. For some activities, visual or practical resources will need to be provided in order to develop understanding of key vocabulary. Use of ICT and audio will enable all learners to access vocabulary ensuring they can achieve the same learning objective as their peers.

We aim to ensure our learners have access to the Moss Valley curriculum that;

- set suitable learning challenges
- responds to pupils' diverse learning needs
- overcome potential barriers to learning
- French lessons that are inclusive, where teachers need to anticipate what barriers to taking part and learning particular activities, lessons or a series of lessons may pose for pupils.
